Everything else remains the same. The [Diploma in Coaching](#) is still an ICF ACTP (accredited coach training programme).

[Part I Professional Coaching Skills](#) is also still available as a stand-alone training course providing 135+ hours of ICF ACSTH (approved coach specific training hours). Graduates can then choose to continue with [Part II Developing Mastery](#) or apply directly to the ICF via the [Portfolio Route](#) to gain a credential.
